Literacy

This week we have been listening to the story Jack and the Beanstalk. The children sequenced events from the beginning of the story and changed passages from present tense to past tense. They have also used contractions in story sentences. Next week we will continue to use this story and rewrite the main events.

Phonics

KS1: The children have been learning how to make singular nouns plural by adding 's' or 'es' if the word ends in -x, -s, ch or -sh. They also learned about some of the more irregular ways of making plurals!

Reception: We have also been learning about how to make simple nouns plural by adding a 's'.

<u>Maths</u>

KS1: The children have been practising their addition and subtraction skills using a number line. All of the children have found this tricky so we will be practicing finding numbers on a number line to 100. The children have been finding 10 more and 10 less on a 100 square and will move on to show this on a number line with a +10 'jump'! Reception: We have been finding 10 more and 10 less than number by jumping up and down the numbers on a 100 square. We have also been counting in 10s and working out simple additions.

<u>Topic</u>

In History, the children have looked at photos of seaside holidays from the past and have sorted photos into 'Then' and 'Now'. The Year 2s made notes about what they noticed in these photos. Our PSHE tied into Earth Day this week, the children found out the role of bees in our ecosystem and how nature 'naturally' recycles. In Art, the children have decorated their rocks to make their favourite minibeasts! They have used different materials for the features and wings and have had a go at using a glue gun. In Science, the children have been learning about the life cycle of a sunflower in preparation of some planting next week!
