

Literacy

The children have listened to the short story Dear Zoo and have used this as a hook to thinking about writing letters. We have looked at how letters are set out differently to other types of writing and thought about how letters start and end. The children have been looking at how to lay out an address when writing a letter, making sure each word has a capital letter and a new line is started for each different part of the address.

Phonics

Reception & KS1: This week all the children have been working together for their phonics inputs. They have been revising how to spell the days of the week and the months of the year. The children have been testing their spelling by working out anagrams and wordsearches with these words.

Maths

KS1: Using 2s, 5s, and 10s, children have been making arrays of objects to work out multiplication and division problems. They have also used written arrays to make repeated addition sums and then work out how to make a multiplication sum. They did this by counting how many 'rows' of objects and multiplying by how many objects in each 'row' to find the answer.
Reception: We have been working out simple sharing problems by counting how many objects altogether in equal groups. We have also been looking at the inverse by working out how many objects will be in each group when shared out fairly.

Topic

In PE this week, the children have been using skills learnt so far this half term as they moved around the playground completing different activities. In Science, the children learned about the life cycle of a butterfly. They watched a time-lapse video showing a caterpillar grow and shed its outer exoskeleton before creating a cocoon and chrysalis before emerging as a butterfly. We will be observing the metamorphosis of our own class caterpillars over the next few weeks. In History, the children have enjoyed talking about what they found out about seaside holidays now and then after talking to family and friends. Mrs Tanner shared some of her and her grandmother's seaside holiday postcards from the past.
